

Summer Reading Instructions for Barnstable Intermediate School

Summer reading is designed to keep students in the habit of reading. Reading fluency promotes better vocabulary. The more you read, the better you will be able to comprehend, interpret and analyze books and texts.

1. Read three books from the list **or by any author on the list.**
 - ✓ Keep notes on one book. *(see Guide Sheet)
 - ✓ Bring those notes to school in September.
 - ✓ An in-class writing assignment will take place within the first two weeks of school. The assignment will be scored and will equal one quiz grade.
