



Student Mobile Device Agreement K-5

- Use of the Internet and your *mobile device* (iPad/Chromebook) is a privilege. You are expected to be a responsible digital citizen at all times. The device issued to you by the school is only to be used for **educational purposes**.
- You must log into your Google Account to use the device.
- You **cannot** listen to music or watch movies without teacher permission. You **cannot** play any games on this device unless your teacher gives your permission. (YouTube, Netflix, etc)
- You cannot take pictures, record videos, or make audio recordings of anyone (students or teachers) without permission.
- You are responsible for bringing your device to and from school each day. There are no loaners.
- Charge the device at night, and leave your charger at home (So you do not lose it!) Fully charged, this device has a 10 hour battery life.
- You are expected to take care of your mobile device: **Take good care of it.**
 - Keep the COVER on the device at all times.
 - Carry the device carefully.
 - Keep food and drinks away from your device.
 - Use your iPad or Chromebook on a solid surface (like a desk or table).
 - Shut down your device at LEAST once a week.
 - If your device needs cleaning, ask your teacher or family member to help you.
- If you think your device isn't working right, contact your teacher right away.

I understand all of the above rules for using my school issued device. I agree to follow these rules, and understand any misuse of my iPad or Chromebook may result in a behavioral consequence and/or loss of use of my device.
